Capone's early life in New York was nothing unusual for Italian immigrants over time. While an agreement was made, it only lasted a couple of months. Valentine's Massacre in 1929, with Capone still dominating the black alcohol market in Chicago, other accessories competed for part of the smuggled cake. That time, Capone and Torrio decided not to move again to escape the problem. He was imprisoned in the infamous prison of Alcatraz Island in 1934. Living in a mental hospital in Baltimore Capone began to suffer from poor health while in prison. Capone got into some mess with the gangs, but it was never serious.
